'Step 'n' snap' walk



A walk to see the neighbourhood through a child's eyes.





Length: A nice long walk

You will need:

- comfortable shoes
- digital camera or smart phone with photo capability
- computer (optional)
- printer (optional)

This is a great way to encourage children to become more familiar with their neighbourhood.

For this walk, you will need to be comfortable with children using your camera or phone. You may choose to use a walking route you are familiar with, or explore something new. Better still, why not let the children take the lead?

Set off on a walk, and let your children take photos of things they like – it may be a funny dog, a favourite driveway, an unusual letterbox or statue, or a sign that makes them laugh. Children love a challenge!

At home, help them download their photos and, if you have a printer, print out their favourites.

TOP TIP: Why not take this walk with children on their regular walking routes, such as on the way home from school, or when walking to a friend's house.
